#### **INCREASE IN POLICE CUSTODIAL DEATHS**

#### 364 SHRI SANJAY SINGH:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise details of custodial deaths during the last five years;
- (b) whether it is a fact that out of all States, Uttar Pradesh has the highest number of police custodial deaths in the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps taken by Government to rectify the situation?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

(a) to (d): A statement indicating number of State/UT-wise custodial deaths during the last five years as received from National Human Rights Commission(NHRC) is placed at Annexure.

As per seventh schedule to the Constitution of India, 'Police', 'Prison' and 'Public Order' are state subjects. It is for the respective State Governments to take action in every crime. The Central Government does not intervene directly in these matters, but does issue advisories from time to time, while the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) issues guidelines and recommendations to be followed by the States/UTs in all cases of custodial deaths. In addition, workshops/ seminars are also organized by NHRC from time to time to sensitize officers in the State Governments for better protection of human rights and particularly protection of rights of persons in custody.
