**CONSTRUCTION/UPGRADATION OF HIGHWAYS IN
MOUNTAINOUS STATES**

406. MS. SAROJ PANDEY:

Will the MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of new highways constructed and old highways upgraded during the last five years in the mountainous and border areas of the country;
- (b) the financial expenditure made by Government for these construction works;
- (c) whether other works of this nature are in progress; and
- (d) if so, the mountainous States in which such projects are in progress and by when these works are expected to be completed?

- (a) & (b) In the last five years, 4358 km of National Highway have been constructed in the mountainous and border areas with an expenditure of Rs.70,733 Cr.
- (c) & (d) Yes Sir. The number of ongoing works for development of NHs in mountainous States and border areas is at Annexure. Based on their stage of progress, these works are targeted to be completed between 2021 and 2023.
