STATUS OF BHARATMALA PROJECT

407. DR. KIRODI LAL MEENA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of Bharatmala project;
- (b) the details of the projects under various phases of the projects completed as on date;
- (c) the time by when the rest of the projects are likely to be completed; and
- (d) the steps being taken by Government in this regard?

- (a) to (c) Out of 34,800 km approved under Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I, projects comprising length of 19,265 km have been awarded, out of this a length of 6,567 Km has been completed. Detailed Project Reports for the remaining length have been initiated with award of these projects targeted by Year 2023 and completion by Year 2025-26.
- (d) The Ministry is working to create a robust pipeline of projects for tracking on daily basis at different levels using technology driven platforms like Data Lake to conduct real time reviews of projects. In addition, Ministry is identifying and resolving issues leading to delay in award and implementation of projects across multiple agencies through Inter-Ministerial Committees.
