SKILL TRAINING CENTRES IN UTTAR PRADESH

428#. SMT. KANTA KARDAM:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the Skill Training Centres in Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) the details of the amount allocated for the development of Skill Training Centres in Uttar Pradesh in comparison to other States; and
- (c) whether Government has taken any step to encourage the participation of women in skill training, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

(a) Under Skill India, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing various programmes/ scheme for the skill development. The number of skill development centres in the State of Uttar Pradesh under the programmes of MSDE is given below:

(b) For establishment of PMKKs, there is no provision of State-wise allocation of funds; however, Ministry through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) provides funding support upto Rs. 70 lakh to training provider (TP). As on 15.11.2021, Rs. 243.19 crore has been disbursed by the NSDC for the establishment of PMKKs across the country. Out of which, Rs. 5.81 crore have been disbursed to TPs for the establishment of PMKKs in State of Uttar Pradesh.

Under JSS, there is no provision for State-wise allocation of funds; however, funds have been released to JSSs directly. A sum of Rs. 344.16 crore has been released to different JSSs across the country including Rs. 70.26 crore to JSSs located in State of Uttar Pradesh during 2018-19 to 2021-22.

PMKVY does not have a mandate to establish training centres, thus, there is no State-wise allocation of funds.

(c) Yes Sir. Under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), in order to increase the participation of women, conveyance cost and boarding & lodging facilities are being provided. Further, the priority group under JSS includes women. Under long term skilling, ITIs exclusively of women have been set up across the country. In addition, 30% of the seats in General ITIs are reserved for women trainees subject to the general reservation policy of the respective State.
