Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has prepared any action plan for making the youth living below poverty line skilled and preparing them in accordance with the demand of the labour market, if so, the details thereof, scheme-wise;
- (b) the total number of youth in the country living below poverty line who are unemployed, State-wise:
- (c) whether Government has conducted any survey in this regard and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the number of functionional institutions providing training in skill development in various States. State-wise details thereof

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

(a) The Government is implementing more than 40 Skill Development Schemes/Programmes across 20 Central Ministries/Departments, for providing a variety of Skill Development training programmes on pan India basis in which 556.1 lakh persons have been trained since the inception of the Skill India Mission, during 2015-16 to 2021-22 (1st Quarter) Number of persons trained under the various schemes being implemented by the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship for the youth living below poverty line is as follows:

S.No.	Schemes	Brief
1	Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY)	Under the scheme, skill training is provided to youth belonging to all sections of the society including BPL category, in various sectors as per the need of the market demand. Under the scheme, till July 2021, 1.26 Crore candidates have been trained.

2	Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS)	The scheme envisages the improvement of the occupational skills and technical knowledge of the non/neo literates. Main target group under the Scheme is youth belonging to the BPL category in the age group of 15-45 years. Under the scheme, 15.10 lakh candidates have been trained till July 2021.
3	National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS)	This Scheme is for promoting apprenticeship training and increasing the engagement of apprentices by providing financial support to industrial establishments undertaking apprenticeship program under The Apprentices Act, 1961. Under the scheme, 10.73 lakh apprentices have been trained till July 2021.
4	Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS)	This scheme is for providing long-term training in 137 trades through 14,716 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) across the country. Under the scheme, 64.01 lakh trainees have been trained till July 2021.

^{*} Beyond these, 117.39 people have benn skilled under Fee-based training by the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC).

- (b) & (c) The National Statistical Office (NSO) under the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation brings out an annual Employment- Unemployment Survey called Periodic Labour Force Survey during 2019-20. As per the PLFS report, State-wise details of unemployment rate in the country are placed at **Annexure I**.
- (d): The State-wise details of number of institutions providing training in skill development under MSDE are placed at **Annexure-II.**
