- (a) the details of financial and other assistance given to Maharashtra State under Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS) during the last five years, year-wise and district-wise;
- (b) the details of facilities, including infrastructure, education, healthcare, nutrition, etc., provided to tribals during the above period; and
- (c) the details of targets set and achieved during the above period, year-wise?

(a) to (c): Ministry of Tribal Affairs has provided financial assistance to Government of Maharashtra under the scheme of Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS) during last 5 years against the activities related to education, health, sanitation, water supply, livelihood, skill development etc. is at **Annexure**. During 2020-21, various projects to the tune of Rs.5034.22 lakh was approved by the Ministry under the scheme. However, no fund could be released to the State during the year pending utilization certificate. Details of provision of funds to various Districts in the State is not maintained by the Ministry.
