PROVISIONING OF DRINKING WATER UNDER JJM

\*81 SHRI VIJAY PAL SINGH TOMAR:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of houses in which drinking water connections have been provided under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in various States including Uttar Pradesh, district-wise;
- (b) the number of drinking water connections to be covered during the next two years under the said Mission; and
- (c) the details of funds allocated under the said Mission, including Uttar Pradesh, district-wise?

(a) to (c) A statement is laid on the table of the House.

**Statement referred in reply of Rajya Sabha Starred Question No. 81 to be answered on 06.12.2021**

(a) & (b) Since August, 2019, Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) is under implementation in partnership with States, to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country by 2024. The estimated outlay for the mission is Rs. 3.60 lakh Crore, out of which central share is Rs. 2.08 lakh Crore.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission, out of 18.93 Crore rural households, 3.23 Crore (17%) households were reported to have tap water connections. In the last 27 months, 5.36 Crore (27.91%) rural households have been provided with tap water connections. Thus, as of date, out of 19.22 Crore rural households in the country, 8.60 Crore (44.7%) households are reported to have provision of tap water supply in their homes.

Year-wise timelines finalized by States/ UTs for making provision of tap water supply to every rural household is as under:

In Goa, Telangana, Haryana, Puducherry, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, provision of tap water supply to all rural households has been made.
