PRIVATISATION OF AIRPORTS

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details and number of airports in the country privatized so far;
- (b) the number of airports in the country run by Adani Airport Limited at present; and
- (c) whether the operation of Trivandrum airport has been initiated fully by Adani Trivandrum International Airport Limited (ATIAL), if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b): So far, Airports Authority of India (AAI) has leased out eight airports namely, Delhi, Mumbai, Ahmedabad, Jaipur, Lucknow, Guwahati, Thiruvananthapuram and Mangaluru for Operations, Management and Development under Public Private Partnership (PPP). Out of these, seven airports viz. Mumbai, Ahmedabad, Jaipur, Lucknow, Guwahati, Thiruvananthapuram and Mangaluru are managed by M/s Adani Enterprises Limited (AEL).
- (c): Yes, Sir. In accordance with terms of the Concession Agreement, Adani Thiruvananthapuram International Airport Limited (ATIAL) has commenced the Management, Operation and Development of the airport from 14.10.2021.
