DILAPIDATED CONDITION OF ROAD IN BIHAR

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether it is a fact that the main road passing through Vaishali-Begusarai via Samastipur connects with Bachhwara National Highway No. 28 via Mahnar, Mohiuddin Nagar Raja Chowk in Bihar;
- (b) Whether it is also a fact that this main road is passing through dense population along the river Ganga has become highly dilapidated and hence causing accidents; and
- (c) if so, Government would consider to renovate this highly dilapidated road, if so, by when?

ANSWER

- (a) The stretch starting from its junction of NH-22 near Hajipur passes through Mahnar and Mohiuddin Nagar and terminating at its junction with NH-122 near Bachwara in the State of Bihar has been declared as NH-122B.
- (b) to (c) The works of development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs) are taken up from time to time as per traffic density, inter-se priority and availability of funds to keep the NHs in traffic worthy conditions. The stretch from Hajipur to Mahnar (km 0+000 to km 29+730) is mostly in good condition and the stretch from Mahnar to Bachwara (km 29+730 to Ch 72+348) is mostly in traffic worthy condition. Ministry has sanctioned the work of Pre-Construction activity for NH-122B from km 0 to Km 72+348 and Improvement to two lane with paved shoulder of NH- 122B from km 29+730 to km 72+348 in State of Bihar under EPC mode for an amount of Rs 624.43 cr. The tender for Improvement to two lane with paved shoulder of NH-122B from km 29+730 to km 72+348 in State of Bihar under EPC mode has been invited and work is likely to start in month of May, 2022.
