**FUNDS FOR PwDs**

SHRI G.C. CHANDRASHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether out of the 1.3 crore of employable Persons with Disability (PwDs) only 34 lakh are currently employed;
- (b) the number of PwDs employed under Government schemes, year-wise from 2017 till date;
- (c) the number of PwDs that Government has trained and the number of such trainees placed under various schemes, year-wise since 2017 till date; and
- (d) whether Government has failed to increase the budget for the National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation despite the assistance required by PwDs in employment?

**ANSWER**

(a) According to Census 2011, there are 2.68 crore persons with disabilities in the country which includes persons with visual, hearing, locomotor, and mental disabilities. As per this Census, 36% persons with disabilities were employed as workers.

(b) & (c) With the objective to provide skill training to persons with disabilities (PwDs) for enabling them to become self-reliant and productive members of the society in order to achieve gainful wage/self-employment and integrate them with the mainstream of the society, the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPWD) implements a "National Action Plan (NAP) for Skill Development of Persons with Disabilities (PwDs)" which was launched in March, 2015. NAP is implemented under the umbrella scheme – "Scheme for Implementation of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (SIPDA)" as per Common Norms guidelines of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE). Under NAP, for imparting training to persons with disabilities (Not less than 15 years and not more than 59 years of age), funds are released to training partners (ETPs) empanelled from Government Organisations (GOs) and Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) as well as organizations of the Department such as National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation (NHFDC), National Institutes (NIs) and Composite Regional Centres (CRCs) directly.

Year-wise data of PwDs trained and employed is not feasible as many a times training projects started in a year are completed in subsequent year and further placement of these trained candidates happens in different years or subsequent year(s). The number of persons with disabilities trained and employed since 2016-17 through Training Partners in the States as on 28.02.2022 is at **Annexure**.

(d) National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation (NHFDC) is a Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) functioning under the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities. The Government has released Rs.399.99 Cr. to National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation since its inception in 1997. The Corporation has catered to loan assistance required by Divyangjan for self-employment out of the said funds. The Corporation has been addressing the loan assistance needs of Divyangjan by ploughing back the funds available with it and did not seek support of Government since Financial Year 2020-21.
