Will the Minister of **Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Central Government has approved detailed project report for construction of National Institute of Design (NID) at Andhra Pradesh and budget has been allocated;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether Government has sanctioned the entire approved budget for the establishment of NID, Andhra Pradesh; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI SOM PARKASH)

(a) to (d): Yes Sir. The Government has approved the budget and Detailed Project Report for construction of NID, Andhra Pradesh. The total budget approved for construction of National Institute of Design (NID) Andhra Pradesh is Rs 100.38 Crore. Rs 0.70 Crore was spent on Pre-construction expenses such as survey and boundary wall. The entire remaining amount has been sanctioned and released - Rs 93.18 Crore to National Building Construction Corporation (NBCC), the project execution agency; and Rs 6.50 Crore to NID Ahmedabad for supply of machinery, equipment and library books.
