(a) to (e): National Education Policy 2020 envisages greater collaboration between academia and industry for promoting holistic and multidisciplinary education with focus on creativity, innovation and employability. Such an initiative will not only bridge the gap between Higher Educational Institutions and industry but also enrich the curriculum and help students' employability. University Grants Commission, without affecting the sanctioned positions of the university, is exploring the possibilities of creating positions such as Professor of Practice based on their industrial experience. Such provisions already exists in IITs.
