Education projects for SCs/STs in Uttar Pradesh

Will the Minister of **Education** be pleased to state:

- (a) the district-wise details of the education projects being run for the children belonging to the Scheduled Castes (SC)/the Scheduled Tribes (ST) in the State of Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) the year-wise and district-wise details of the funds allocated/released for the said projects in the State of Uttar Pradesh during the last three years and the current year;
- (c) the district-wise details of the funds spent on the higher education projects during the said period; and
- (d) the steps taken/being taken by Government for effective implementation of such educational projects in the State of Uttar Pradesh?

(a): The Department has launched the Samagra Shiksha – an Integrated Scheme for School Education from 2018-19. It envisages the 'school' as a continuum from pre-school, primary, upper primary, secondary to Senior Secondary levels. It is an overarching programme for the school education sector extending from pre-school to class XII and aims to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education at all levels of school education. Samagra Shiksha is implemented in partnership with all the States and UTs including Uttar Pradesh and financial assistance is provided to all States and UTs for various components including strengthening of ICT infrastructure in schools from upper primary to higher secondary level, opening /strengthening of new schools upto senior secondary level, construction of school buildings and additional classroom, setting up, up-gradation and running of Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV) for girls belonging to SC, ST, OBC, Minority and Below Poverty Line (BPL) families, setting up of residential schools/hostels, free textbooks to all children and free uniforms to all girls, SC, ST and BPL boys at elementary level including primers/textbooks for tribal languages with bridging materials.

(b): The Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Samagra Shiksha is implemented through a single State Implementing Society (SIS) set up by respective State/UT. Funds are allocated to the States/UTs after following a detailed process of appraisal of State/UT plan, on annual basis. The details of the funds released under Samagra Shiksha for the State of Uttar Pradesh during the last three years and the current year is as under:
