- (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. National Archives of India has launched the first phase of a project for digitization of 4.50 crore pages of records in January, 2021 through outsourcing.
- (c) The project seeks to provide accessibility and retrieval of digital data electronically to scholars, historians, academicians and other users of archives world over.
