Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- a) whether Government has received any proposal from Karnataka Government relating to Vanbandhu Kalyan Yojana (VKY) and conservation-cum-development plan for particularly vulnerable groups;
- b) if so, the details thereof, as on date;
- c) the present status of the said proposal; and
- d) the time by when the said proposal is likely to be finalized along with the reasons for delay therein?

(a) to (d): Government has approved the scheme 'Pradhan Mantri Van Bandhu Kalyan Yojna (PMVKY)' implementation during 2021-22 to 2025-26 wherein following components are there:

- i. 'Pre-Matric Scholarship'
- ii. 'Post- Matric Scholarship'
- iii. 'Support to Tribal Research Institute'
- iv. 'Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs)'
- v. 'Pradhan Mantri Aadi Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAAGY)'

Details of proposals submitted by Government of Karnataka and present status thereof under these scheme components for the year 2021-22 are as under:

Details of the activities sanctioned under the scheme of 'Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs)' during the year 2021-22 to Government of Karnataka is at **Annexure**. Under the Scheme PMAAGY, funds to the tune of Rs. 2140.00 lakh commensurating to 50% of the allocated share (@ Rs. 20.38 lakh per village) for 210 villages has been released as gap filling for transforming these villages into model villages (Adarsh Gram) with appropriate convergence of resources under various schemes of Central and State Government meant for tribal development. The State Government has to submit the consolidated village development plan for these 210 villages to the Ministry of Tribal Affairs.
