(a):The total funds allocated for Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC) during the last three years and the current year is Rs. 564.00 crore. The year-wise/ State-wise details are at Annexure-A.

(b):C-DAC imparts various training programmes under Advanced Computing Training School (ACTS). As part of the same, C-DAC is conducting the Post Graduate Diploma programmes at C-DAC training centres. The details of the total number of students who have been trained in the C-DAC centres in the same period, State-wise and year-wise are at Annexure-B.

(c):Yes, Sir. Trainings are conducted effectively and the students are showing keen interest in these training programmes.

(e): The course curriculum is aligned with the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) level 8 and updated as per industry standards every year to improve the quality of training.
