Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a)whether as per Government's periodic Labour Force Survey for April to July 2021 released on 14th March, 2022, urban unemployment rose during 2nd wave of the COVID- 19 pandemic;
- (b)if so, the details thereof, sector and State-wise;
- (c) the details of number of unemployed persons in the country as on date, State-wise; and
- (d) the details of unemployed persons in the country as on 31st March, 2019. State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (d): As per the Quarterly Bulletin (April-June 2021) and (July-September 2021) of Periodic Labour Force Survey(PLFS) conducted by National Statistical Office(NSO), Unemployment Rate (UR) according to Current Weekly Status (CWS) in urban areas in India of persons of age 15 years and above has decreased from 12.6% to 9.8%. The State-wise estimates of Unemployment Rate (UR) according to Current Weekly Status (CWS) in urban areas of persons of age 15 years and above is given at annexure-I.

The all India Unemployment rate (UR) according to usual status (ps+ss) of persons of age 15 years and above in all India has decreased from 5.8 % in PLFS (2018-19) to 4.8% in PLFS (2019-20).

The Unemployment Rate (UR) (in per cent) according to usual status (ps+ss) of persons of age 15 years and above during PLFS (2018-19) and PLFS(2019-20) for each State/UT is given at Annexure-II.
