The applications for compassionate appointment in the Indian Air Force (IAF) to the posts at Level-1 and Level-2 are received through various Command HQs and Directorate of Air Veterans (DAV) for dependents of Air Force personnel. The service liability of such appointee is pan India, and hence, state-wise details are not available. However, number of appointments on compassionate grounds provided to the dependents of deceased Government servants by IAF are as follows:-

Financial year	Dependent of Airmen/ NCs(E)
2018 – 19	01
2019 – 20	04
2020 – 21	05

The Indian Army does not maintain centralized data on compassionate appointments and the same is maintained by the concerned Line Directorates.

Under the compassionate appointment scheme, the appointment is restricted to 5% of direct recruitment vacancies, hence, applicants who fail to get selected due to lower merit points are rejected for that particular year. However, these applicants have the option to re-apply for appointment on compassionate grounds in subsequent years.
