Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the grants released to all States/UTs for the last three years under the scheme of Assistance to Training Institutions(ATIs);
- (b) the number of training institutions in Puducherry registered under the scheme; and
- (c) the details of institutions in Puducherry which received assistance for the last three years for the development of infrastructure to impart training?

(a): The grants-in-aid were released to existing State Level Entrepreneurship Development Institutes (EDIs) owned and controlled by State Governments/UTs for creation or strengthening/expansion of their infrastructure during last three years and current year under the ATI Scheme, as per details given below:-
