- (a) whether Government has any data on the number of cases of corruption registered against the Central Government employees during the last five years;
- (b) if so, the year and department-wise details thereof, for the last five years;
- (c) the details of action taken against each cases, such as suspension and dismissal from the services, separately for the same period; and
- (d) the department or sector-wise break up of employees booked under bribery and corruption charges?

(a) to (d) Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has registered 715 cases of corruption against the Central Government Employees working in 45 Departments, during the last five years from 2017 to 2021. Year-wise details of these cases are as under: -
