ASSET MONETISATION OF SPORTS FACILITIES

3354 SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR GUPTA:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government will soon appoint a transaction adviser for the asset monetisation of the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium and the Indira Gandhi Sports complex;
- (b) if so, the details thereof particularly with regard to security and other related issues; and
- (c) the other stadiums or sports facilities which are in the list of monetisation programme?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) In order to implement the Budget Announcement of Financial Year 2021-22 related to Asset Monetisation, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports has appointed the Transaction Adviser (TA) for development of Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium (JNS), Delhi as 'New Delhi Sports Hub' on Public Private Partnership (PPP) basis.

The TA, shall carry out technical analysis and financial modelling including the security and other related issues. Based on theses analysis TA will prepare the Request for Proposal (RFP) and Request for Quotation (RFQ) for the appointment of Concessionaire. At this stage TA has not indicted any security issues related to Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium (JNS), Delhi.

(c) The National Monetisation Pipeline (NMP), a Government of India's pioneering initiative to establish a medium-term pipeline along with a roadmap for "monetization ready" assets have identified the following assets related to Department of Sports for monetisation during Financial Years 2022-2025:

1. Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium (JNS), Delhi
2. Indira Gandhi Stadium , Delhi
3. Sports Authority of India (SAI) Regional Centre (RC), Zirakpur, Punjab
4. SAI RC, Bengaluru
