(a) to (c) The total number of users of Domestic LPG in the country is 30.49 crore as on 01.03.2022. Details of state-wise LPG coverage are at Annexure. The consumption of Domestic LPG has gone up from 21727.5 TMT in 2018-19 to 23076.6 TMT in 2019-20 and 25127.6 TMT in 2020-21.
