(a) to (c): The data for Capital Expenditure for the Budgetary Allocation, Revised Estimates and Actual Expenditure from 2017-18 to 2021-22 is as under -

It would be seen that average utilisation of funds with reference to Revised Estimates during 2017-18 to 2020-21 is around 92%. Utilization of less than 100% funds could be attributable to multiple reasons including failure of contract, non-availability of land from concerned State Governments, non-availability of timely clearances etc.
