- (a) the findings of the five member inquiry constituted to look into the causes related to recent violent protests after the RRB NTPC results;
- (b) whether Railways recognise the facts that the unusual delay and partial declaration of results for the posts advertised should have been avoided;
- (c) whether the results of Computer Based Tests 1 for the Non-Technical Popular Category Group C posts had many instances of name of same candidate displayed at more than one place; and
- (d) the reasons for not declaring the results of examination for Group D posts when the exam was conducted along with the Group C posts?
