**PLI SCHEME FOR TEXTILES**

3512. SHRI K.J. ALPHONS:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme for the textile industry;
- (b) the allocation for the scheme during the financial year 2022-23; and
- (c) the companies selected for assistance under PLI scheme?

**ANSWER**

**(a):** Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Textiles has been approved to promote production of MMF Apparel, MMF Fabrics and Products of Technical Textiles in the country with a budgetary outlay of Rs 10,683 crore. The objective is to enable Textile sector in the said segments to achieve size and scale and to become competitive.

**(b):** The gestation period of the scheme is two (2) years i.e. FY: 2022-23 to FY: 2023-2024. The allocation for the scheme during the financial year 2022-23 (B.E.) is Rs. 15.00 crore for administrative expenditure.

**(c):** The last date for submission of applications under the PLI Scheme for Textiles was 28.02.2022. In accordance with the scheme guidelines, selection of applicants will be finalized within 60 days from the date of closure of application window.
