MODERNIZATION SCHEME FOR CRPF

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has approved modernization scheme-IV for modernizing CRPF;
- (b) the salient features of this scheme;
- (c) the details of the funds allocated for the ensuing five years under this, CPF-wise and the duration of completion of modernization work; and
- (d) the details of the modern equipment proposed to be purchased under this scheme?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

(a) to (c): Yes Sir. Government has approved Modernization Plan–IV for Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs), including Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), with a total financial outlay of ₹ 1523 crore, in continuation of Modernization Plan-III, till 31.03.2026. Out of this amount, CRPF has been allocated ₹ 484.58 crore under this scheme.

Through this plan, CAPFs will be further equipped with the latest weapons, surveillance and communication equipment, specialized vehicles, protective gears etc. to enable them to perform important tasks such as guarding the

borders and maintaining internal security. This plan would bridge the gap between the existing inventory/technology held by CAPFs and the latest appropriate state of the art technology in view of the current security scenario across the country.

Fund allocation to CAPFs is done on yearly basis. CAPF wise fund allocation for the financial year 2022-23 under this scheme is as under:
