- (e) whether Government has allocated additional funds for the MGNREGA scheme over and above the budget estimates for this year; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): State/UT-wise details of funds released under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) in the financial year 2021-22 (as on 29.03.2022) is given at **Annexure-I**.

(c) & (d): State/UT-wise details of pending liabilities for wage component under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS as on 02.04.2022 are given at **Annexure-II**.

(e) & (f): There was a budget allocation of Rs. 73,000 crore at Budget Estimate (BE) stage under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS which is enhanced to Rs. 98,000 crore at Revised Estimate (RE) stage with an increase of Rs. 25,000 crore during the financial year 2021-22.
