### PASSENGER SHIP SERVICE TO LAKSHADWEEP ISLANDS

#### 3823. SHRI ABDUL WAHAB:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that there has been a decline in the number of passenger ship services to Lakshadweep Islands;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) if not, the details of number of passenger ship services and number of passengers towards various islands of Lakshadweep, year-wise for the last five years; and
- (d) whether Government is considering to increase the number of passenger ships towards Lakshadweep Islands as per the demand?

- (a) No, Sir.
- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) There are 15 number of passenger ship (05 all weather passenger cum cargo ships, 02 fair weather passenger cum cargo ships and 08 fair weather inter-island high speed crafts) available under Lakshadweep Administration for catering the services of movement of passengers and cargo in the islands of Lakshadweep. The details of last five years of number of passengers towards various islands of Lakshadweep are as under:
