PLAN TO CONNECT CITIES WITH PORTS THROUGH RIVERS

3824. SMT. GEETA ALIAS CHANDRAPRABHA:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a plan to connect the cities situated on the banks of major rivers with ports through rivers; and
- (b) if so, the total number of rivers and cities in the country which have been selected for this?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) No, Sir. There is no such plan. Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI), an autonomous organisation under Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways is mandated with development of National Waterways (NWs) for the purpose of shipping and navigation. 111 Waterways (including 5 existing and 106 new) have been declared as National Waterways under the National Waterways Act, 2016. Out of the 111 NWs, 19 NWs have port connectivity and details of cities connected to the ports through these NWs is given at **Annex**.

Major Ports connectivity to hinterland through National Waterways:
