STARRED QUESTION NO. \* 387 FOR REPLY ON 07.4.2022**

(a) : Yes Sir, Ministry of Culture operates two schemes namely Museum Grant Scheme (MGS) and Scheme for Promotion of Culture of Science (SPoCS), one of the components of whom is development/modification of existing museums and modernization/upgradation of existing Science Cities/Science Centres/Innovation Hubs respectively.

These schemes aim to provide financial assistance to modernize/upgrade and create a congenial spatial setting for diverse exhibitions, galleries and visitors amenities in the existing Museums and Science Cities/Science Centres/Innovation Hubs.

(b) to (d) : During the last two years (2020-21 and 2021-22), 8 museums have been funded under Museum Grant Scheme for development/modernization of existing museums. Similarly 13 Science Cities/Science Centres/Innovation Hubs have been funded under Scheme for Promotion of Culture of Science for modernization, renovation and improvement of existing facilities.

Details of financial assistance provided by Ministry of Culture for development/modifications of museums under Museum Grant Scheme and modernization/upgradation of existing Science Cities/Science Centres/Innovation Hubs under Scheme for Promotion of Culture of Science during last two years (2020-21 and 2021-22) are enclosed at **Annexure-I & Annexure-II** respectively.
