Environmental clearance for Ken Betwa River Link Project

- (a) the status of the approval of environmental clearance for 'Ken Betwa River Link Project', whether approval has already been granted;
- (b) if so, whether the entire project has been approved; and
- (c) if not, by when this approval is likely to be granted?

- (a) to (c) The KenBetwa Project is a river link project is being implemented in two phases namely:
 - 1. Ken-Betwa Link Project Phase I
 - 2. Ken-Betwa Link Project, Phase-II

The Ken-Betwa Link Project Phase – I comprise following components:

- i. Construction of an earth fill and concrete dam near Daudhan village on Ken river
- ii. Link canal for transferring water from Ken river to Betwa basin

The Ken-Betwa Link Project, Phase-II envisages construction of following projects:

- i. Bina Complex Multipurpose Project (32MW) at Village Chakarpur, Tehsil Sagar, District Sagar in Madhya Pradesh
- ii. Lower Orr Dam project at Village Didoni, Tehsil Chanderi, District Ashoknagar, Madhya Pradesh
- iii. Kotha Barrage major irrigation project at Village Kotha, Tehsil Kurwai, District Vidisha, Madhya Pradesh

The following projects under Ken- Betwa Link project have been granted EC under the provisions of the EIA Notification, 2006, as amended after detailed appraisal by the EAC/SEAC constituted by the Ministry:

Phase I

(i) Environment Clearance to Ken-Betwa Link Project Phase-I at Village Daudhan, Tehsil Bijawar, District Chhatarpurin Madhya Pradesh has been accorded by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) on 25.08.2017.

Phase II

- (i) Environment Clearance to Bina Complex Multipurpose Project (32MW) at Village Chakarpur, Tehsil Sagar, District Sagar in Madhya Pradesh has been accorded by MoEF&CC on 22.02.2017.
- (ii) Environment Clearance to Kotha Barrage major irrigation project at Village Kotha, Tehsil Kurwai, District Vidisha, Madhya Pradesh has been accorded by State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), MP on 21.08.2020.
- (iii) Lower Orr Project has been recommended by Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) for grant of Environmental Clearance (EC) in its 93rd meeting held on 02.05.2016 subject to submission of Stage-I Forest Clearance (FC) for diversion of 968.24 ha forest land involved in the project. Project Proponent submitted the Stage-I FC online on 16.10.2020 for grant of Environmental Clearance after 31 months. Accordingly, as per the provision, proposal was referred to EAC for having a relook, EAC after considering the proposal in its 3rdmeeting held on 29.10.2020 sought additional information on certain points for further consideration. The desired information has not been submitted to the Ministry.
