- (a) whether the Sports Authority of India (SAI) has selected land for National High Altitude Sports Training Centre in Dharamshala, Kangra;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the area of land selected for the National High-Altitude Sports Training Centre; and
- (d) whether play ground for hockey would also be prepared in this Centre?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Sports is a State Subject and the primary responsibility of development of sports, including setting up of training centres, rests with the State Governments and the National Sports Federations (NSFs) which are responsible for governance of individual sports disciplines.

The Central Government compliments and supplements the efforts of State Governments and the NSFs through its various Sports Development Schemes as also through the Sports Authority of India.

SAI, in consultation with the Government of Himachal Pradesh has identified a piece of land in Dharamshala, Kangra for establishment of a High Altitude Sports Training Centre and other Sports facilities.
