- (a) Component-wise details of progress under PM-KUSUM Scheme as on 28.02.2022 is as given below:

Component	Sanctioned	Commissioned
Component-A (Grid-connected solar power plant)	4909 MW	30 MW
Component-B (Standalone solar pumps)	3,59,462 nos.	82,408 nos.
Component-C (Solarization of existing agriculture pumps)	10,01,077 nos.	1,026 nos.

- (b) Year-wise details of the funds released under the Scheme since inception as on 28.02.2022 is as given below:

Year	Funds Released (Rs. Cr.)
FY 2019-20	151.26
FY 2020-21	156.43
FY 2021-22	375.47

- (c) Besides PM-KUSUM Scheme, Government has also launched Rooftop Solar Scheme targeting installation of aggregated 4000 MW capacity rooftop solar plants in the residential sector, in urban as well as rural areas, with central financial assistance (CFA), by the year 2022.
