Expenditure on higher education schemes

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the annual budget allocations and the actual expenditure during the last five years under specific higher education schemes, namely, UGC Major Research Projects, UGC Minor Research Projects, RUSA, IMPRESS (ICSSR social science research funding programme) and IMPRINT (Ministry of Science and Technology research funding programme);
- (b) the annual expenditure on higher education as a whole in each of the preceding five years and the percentages of the Central budgets in terms of GDP; and
- (c) what are Government's specific plans to improve higher education in the country?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

- (a): The details of Annual budget estimate and the actual expenditure during the last five years under the schemes of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), Impactful Policy Research in Social Science (IMPRESS), Impacting Research Innovation and Tehcnology (IMPRINT) and details of grants released by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under its scheme of Minor and Major Research Project (Science & Humanities) are at Annexure I.
- (b): Details of expenditure on education as percent of GDP are at Annexure II.
- (c): Improving the quality of education across all levels is a continuous and ongoing process. In this direction, the Government has announced the National Education Policy 2020 on 29.07.2020 which aims to address the many growing developmental imperatives of our country. This Policy proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education structure, including its regulation and governance, accessibility, equity, inclusivity and affordability to create a new system while building upon India's traditions and value systems.
