Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that a postal stamp was released in the name of Jan Nayak Karpoori Thakur;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that this stamp is currently not available; and
- (c) if so, whether Government proposes to re-introduce the postal stamp issued in the name of Jan Nayak Karpoori Thakur?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) As per the guidelines on the subject, commemorative postage stamps remaining unsold in Philatelic Bureaux after 6 months are released for sale in post offices along with definitive stamps. The Commemorative Postage Stamp issued on Jan Nayak Karpoori Thakur in the year 2016 is available in limited quantities in Delhi and Uttar Pradesh Postal Circles.
- (c) As per the existing guidelines, there is no provision to re-introduce a Commemorative Postage Stamp.
