Development of fisheries sector in Gujarat

419 Shri Narhari Amin:

Will the Minister of **Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying** be pleased to state:

- (a) the scheme-wise details of the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilized for development of fisheries sector in the State of Gujarat during the last three years and the current financial year; and
- (b) whether Government has received the utilization report from the State Government during this period, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) and (b): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying during the last three years and current fiscal year accorded approval to the proposals of Government of Gujarat at a total cost of Rs. 48589.19 lakh under various schemes and released the Central fund of Rs. 8119.35 lakh to the State Government for development of fisheries in the State. Out of the Central funds released, the Government of Gujarat has reported utilization of Rs. 1900.67 lakh for development of fisheries during the above said period. Scheme-wise details of the funds sanctioned, released and utilized for development of fisheries in the State of Gujarat during last three years and current year are as below:
