Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) when was the proposal to set up 350 bedded ESI hospital in Andhra Pradesh with an estimated cost of ₹ 500 crores mooted;**
- (b) whether tender has been issued for construction of the above hospital;**
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the timeline by which the hospital is scheduled to be completed and whether the works are as per schedule; and**
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor, apart from pandemic?**

(a) to (d): The proposal to set up 400-bedded hospital (350 bed hospital with an additional 50-bedded Super Specialty Treatment wing) has been approved by the Employees' State Insurance Corporation in its meeting held on 22.02.2021. The concept plan and estimates for an amount of Rs.384.26 crores have been approved. The work has been assigned to Central Public Works Department (CPWD). The tender has not been issued by the CPWD so far.
