PROJECTS UNDER THE AMRUT SCHEME IN HARYANA

NO. 533. SHRI DEEPENDER SINGH HOODA:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of district-wise ongoing projects under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) in Haryana;
- (b) whether Government has a mechanism to monitor projects undertaken by various Municipal Corporations and other bodies;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether Government has received complaints of misappropriation of funds meant for development works in Faridabad MC of Haryana; and
- (e) if so, the complete details thereof including the action taken?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS

(SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

(a): Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) was launched on 25 June 2015 in selected 500 cities and towns across the country. The Mission focuses on development of basic infrastructure in the selected cities and towns, in the sectors of water supply; sewerage and septage management; storm water drainage; green spaces and parks; and non-motorized urban transport. The details of AMRUT projects taken up by the Government of Haryana in AMRUT cities of the State of Haryana is given at ANNEXURE.

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(b) and (c): The progress of works under AMRUT is periodically reviewed and monitored through regular video conferences, webinars, workshops etc. by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs. There is a dedicated AMRUT portal for tracking the progress of projects. State is required to update data on the portal on regular basis. At the State level, progress of the Mission is being monitored by State level High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary. Progress of the Mission is also periodically reviewed by the Apex Committee under the Chairmanship of the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs. Further, Independent Review and Monitoring Agencies (IRMAs) have been appointed for each State for periodical external monitoring of implementation of projects under AMRUT at field level.

(d) and (e): Ministry has not received any complaint of misappropriation of funds meant for development of works under AMRUT in Faridabad Municipal Corporation, Haryana.
