STATUS OF IRRIGATION SCHEME IN MADHYA PRADESH

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of the irrigation scheme in which irrigation was proposed from Chinki village to Udaipura of Raisen district through pipes under the lift irrigation project on Narmada river in Chinki village of Narsingpur district in Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) if not, progress in this regard, the reasons therefor: and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Water resources projects are planned, funded, executed, and maintained by the State Governments themselves as per their own resources and priorities. Role of Government of India is limited to providing technical support and, in some cases, partial financial assistance under the existing schemes implemented by the Ministry of Jal Shakti. However, for major and medium inter-state irrigation projects, appraisal is being undertaken by Central Water Commission under this Ministry.

No reference on the lift irrigation project on Narmada river in Chinki village of Narsingpur district in Madhya Pradesh is being dealt with, or pending in this Ministry.

As informed by Government of Madhya Pradesh, the project in question is titled Chinki-Boras Barrage Combined Multipurpose Project being implemented by Narmada Valley Development Authority, Government of Madhya Pradesh.

It has been further informed by the State Government that work for construction of the project has been awarded in December, 2021. Detailed survey work and geo-technical investigations for construction of barrages, power houses and piped micro irrigation network pertaining to the project, are reported to be in progress.
