### Reviving the education sector

#### 836 SHRI SUJEET KUMAR:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of expenditure on education by Government over the last five years split over primary, secondary and tertiary sectors;
- (b) the expenditure of the same as a percentage of GDP over the last five years;
- (c) whether Government is planning to bring in any new programmes so as to revive the education sector in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

# **ANSWER** MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) The details of expenditure on education by Government from 2014-15 to 2018-19 split over primary, secondary, adult and tertiary (includes University & Higher education, Technical Education) sectors as per Analysis of Budgeted Expenditure on Education are as below:
