**STATUS OF IN-PRINCIPALLY DECLARED HIGHWAYS IN RAJASTHAN**

- (a) whether Government intends to consider necessary Gazette Notification for declaration of National Highway for already in-principally declared 50 highways having length of 4772 kilometres in Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, by when and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) when will Government declare these 50 highways in-principally as National Highways and when will the required improvement works on these highways be done?
