- (a) by when the proposal for construction of four lane road from the border of Karnataka to Gutti in Andhra Pradesh with an estimated cost of ₹ 995 crores is going to start;
- (b) the present status of the project;
- (c) whether there is any time and cost overrun of the project;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) by when the project is likely to be completed?

(a) to (e) The construction of four lane road from the border of Karnataka to Gutti in Andhra Pradesh has already been commenced on 06.05.2016 and was scheduled to be completed on 05.05.2018. The present physical progress of this work is 80.1%. However, due to reasons such as delay in Land Acquisition, Covid-19 pandemic, delay in railway clearance etc., the project could not be completed within the scheduled completion date. Project is likely to be completed by 31st December 2022. There is no cost overrun in the project.
