PROCUREMENT OF EQUIPMENTS UNDER PM SWASTHYA SURAKSHA YOJANA

763. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY VEMIREDDY:

Will the Minister of Health and Family Welfare be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of procurement of equipments proposed for Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS), Tirupati, under PM Swasthya Suraksha Yojana in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) whether it is a fact that Government proposed to set up Super Speciality Blocks in Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada and also in Government Medical College, Anantapur;and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the status of setting up of the Super Speciality Blocks?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a): Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS), Tirupati was approved for upgradation through procurement of medical equipment, under Phase-I of Pradhan Mantri Swasthaya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) at a total cost of Rs. 120 Crore (Central Share Rs. 60 crore and Institute Share Rs. 60 crore). The Central share to the tune of Rs. 58.31 crore has been released for this project.
- (b) & (c): Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada and Government Medical College, Anantapur were taken up for upgradation, through construction of Super Speciality Blocks, under phase-III of PMSSY at an approved cost of Rs. 150 Crore each (Central share Rs. 120 Crore & State share Rs. 30 Crore). The civil work of both the Super Specialty Blocks has been completed.
