RURAL ELECTRIFICATION

797 # SHRI NEERAJ DANGI:

Will the Minister of **POWER** be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise details of schemes initiated in the power sector in various States along with the State of Rajasthan;
- (b) the details of funds released State-wise during the last three years and the current year; and
- (c) the total number of villages electrified in the country during the last two years?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF POWER AND NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY (SHRI R.K. SINGH)

(a): Government of India had launched Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY) in December 2014 for the rural areas with the objectives of electrification of all unelectrified villages as per Census 2011; Strengthening and augmentation of sub-transmission & distribution infrastructure in rural areas, including construction of HT and LT lines, metering at distribution transformers, feeders and consumers; and feeder segregation and electrification of villages across the country including Rajasthan.

Government of India had also launched the Pradhan Mantri Sahaj Bijli Har Ghar Yojana-Saubhagya in October, 2017 with the objective of achieving universal household electrification. The scheme entailed providing electricity connections to all un-electrified households in rural areas and all poor households in urban areas in the country. As on 31.3.2019, all households were reported electrified by the States, except 18,734 households in Left Wing Extremists (LWE) affected areas of Chhattisgarh. Subsequently, seven States namely Assam, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Manipur, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh reported that around 19.09 lakh un-electrified households, identified before 31.03.2019, which were unwilling earlier but later on expressed willingness to get electricity connection. All these seven States have reported 100% household's electrification as on 31.03.2021. Since the launch of Saubhagya, a total of 2.817 crore households have been electrified, upto 31.03.2021.

Under the aegis of Saubhagya scheme, which has now been closed, a total of 20,75,522 households have been reported as electrified in Rajasthan. Based on the request of Rajasthan, electrification of 2,10,843 additional households sanctioned under DDUGJY New in July, 2021 against which 33,523 households have been electrified as on 31.01.2022.

In addition, Government of India had launched Integrated Power Development Scheme (IPDS) in December, 2014 under which various Distribution Infrastructure projects such as Strengthening of sub-transmission and distribution networks in urban areas; Metering of distribution transformers / feeders / consumers in the urban areas; IT enablement works; Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP); Smart Metering; Gas insulated Sub-stations (GIS); and, Real Time Data Acquisition System (RT-DAS).

So far, projects worth Rs.30,802 Crore [with Government of India (GoI) Grant of Rs. 19,322 Crore] have been sanctioned under IPDS covering project components outlined herein, of which GoI Grant of Rs.16,717 Crore has been released to States/UTs.

- (b): State-wise and year-wise details of funds released under DDUGJY, Saubhagya and IPDS, are given at **Annexures-I**, **II & III** respectively.
- (c): As reported by the States, all the inhabited un-electrified census villages in the country stand electrified on 28th April, 2018. Under DDUGJY, 18,374 un-electrified census villages were reported to be electrified during the period from 2014-15 until 28.04.2018.
