**NO. 1362. SHRI BHASKAR RAO NEKKANTI:**

**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether Government has a scheme called “Housing for All” for the State of Odisha;
- (b) if so, the number of houses constructed in the State of Odisha during the last two years and the current year;
- (c) the details of beneficiaries in Koraput and Rayagada districts in Odisha during the last year and the current year;
- (d) whether the State Government of Odisha has not made any budgetary provision for Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) since 2019-20; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the total funds received by the State Government of Odisha from Government for PMAY since 2018?

**ANSWER**

(a) Yes Sir; Union Government through its schemes of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban (PMAY-U) and Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G) under ‘Housing for All’ Mission aims to provide all whether pucca houses with basic amenities to the eligible beneficiaries in urban and rural areas of the country including those of Odisha.

(b) Out of 1,85,152 houses sanctioned under PMAY-U for the State of Odisha, 49,913 houses have been constructed during last two years and current year. Under PMAY-G, 8,45,335 houses have been constructed in the State during the said period.

(c) Number of houses sanctioned in Koraput and Rayagada Districts of Odisha during the last year and the current year are given as under:

District Name	PMAY-U	PMAY-G
Koraput	8,509	2,522
Rayagada	2,121	4,701

(d) & (e) As reported by State Government of Odisha, a budgetary provision of ₹1,217.96 crore has been made by the State since 2019-20 for implementation of PMAY-U. Union Government has released Central Assistance of ₹1,420.04 crore and ₹9,320.79 crore under PMAY-U and PMAY-G respectively to the State Government of Odisha since 2018.
