ACHIEVEMENTS IN RAJASTHAN IN PROVIDING TAP WATER

1367 SHRI K.J. ALPHONS:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) what percentage of households have potable tap water connection in Rajasthan;
- (b) what is the number of connections provided during the last two years; and
- (c) when will all the households receive tap water connection?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Since August 2019, Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country, including those in Rajasthan, by 2024.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission, 11.74 lakh (11.11%) rural households in the State of Rajasthan were reported to have tap water connections. As reported, 12.34 lakh (11.68%) rural households have been provided with tap water connections in last two and half years. Thus, as of date, out of 105.69 lakh rural households in Rajasthan, 24.08 lakh (22.79%) households are reported to have tap water supply in their homes.
