USE OF POST OFFICES FOR MULTI PRONGED ACTIVITIES OF GOVERNMENT

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- a) whether Government has any plan to use the existing post offices and postal employee population for multi pronged activities of Government schemes of various departments;
- b) if so, the details thereof;
- c) the effective steps taken by Government to use the existing infrastructure and land belonging to Postal Department; and
- d) the details of the total employees in Postal Department, State-wise, and the asset value?

(a) & (b) Post Offices are also offering various other Government services in addition to postal services viz. Aadhar Enrolment and updation, Passport Seva Kendra, Passenger Reservation facilities, Sale of Sovereign Gold Bonds, Digital Life Certificates, Direct Benefit transfer of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Common Service centre etc.

(c) In order to ensure optimum utilisation of the infrastructure and land available, Department regularly reviews its offerings and takes appropriate action to offer value additions to make the products/ services more customer and business centric and also generate additional revenue for the Department. Further, new products and services are also introduced as per customer's requirements and market needs. In this regard, Department has also set up bulk mail/ Parcel Processing centres and established Nodal delivery centres.

(d) State-wise details of the departmental employees of the Department of Posts is given in **Annexure**. No data is maintained in respect of asset value.
