SUPPLY OF COVID-19 VACCANCIES TO FOREIGN COUNTRIES 1541. SHRI K. SOMAPRASAD:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and quantity of vaccines supplied to various countries so far, as stated by Hon'ble PM of India in World Economic Forum, Davos Agenda that our country has given essential medicines and vaccines to various countries; and
- (b) whether Government of India has supplied any medical aid other than vaccine or medicines, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) and (b) As per the information provided by the Ministry of External Affairs, by 21st February 2022, a total of 16.29 crore Covid-19 vaccine doses have been supplied to ninety-eight countries. These vaccines have been supplied in the form of grants-in-aid, commercial sales by Indian manufacturers and through GAVI's COVAX facility.

Along with vaccine or medicines, Government of India has supplied material like oxygen concentrators, ventilators, protective gear, thermometers, sampling tubes, swabs, IV fluids, syringes, test kits etc. to sixty-five countries, through Ministry of External Affairs.
