**Vacant teaching posts in IITs and IIMs**

**1615. SHRI SANJAY RAUT:**

Will the Minister of **Education** be pleased to state:

- a) whether it is a fact that over 40 per cent of teaching posts in all 23 Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) are vacant;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and Government's response thereto;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that the quality of education is deteriorating in these institutions due to lack of professors;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the details of steps taken or proposed to be taken by Government to fill the vacant posts with qualified/best faculty in IITs and IIMs?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b): The details of faculty in position and vacant faculty posts in IITs are at **Annexure.**

(c) to (e): IITs are autonomous institutes governed by the Institutes of Technology Act, 1961 and the Statutes framed there under from time to time. Filling up of vacancies is a continuous process and IITs issue rolling Advertisements, which are open throughout the year for all candidates, who fulfill the required qualifications and experience for faculty positions in IITs. Further, Government has implemented 10% reservation for admission of students under EWS category without any reduction in the number of seats available to GEN/ SC/ST/OBC categories by increasing the student strength by 25%. Accordingly, requirement of faculty has increased in IITs. The faculty recruitment takes time since it involves a number of stages in the process. Ministry of Education has requested all IITs to fill up the vacancies in faculty cadre through Special Recruitment Drive in Mission Mode. Further, IIMs also follow rolling advertisement system for applications for the faculty positions and have also been asked to fill vacancies in a Mission Mode.
