EVACUATION OF INDIANS FROM UKRAINE

- (a) the number of flights which have been organised to evacuate Indians from Ukraine and neighbouring countries;
- (b) the number of persons who have been evacuated thus far;
- (c) the amount spent on these evacuations; and
- (d) whether evacuees have been charged for their evacuation and, if so, how much?

- (a) and (b) Around 22,500 Indian nationals have returned from Ukraine to India from 1 February 11 March, 2022. 90 evacuation flights were operated under Operation Ganga including 14 Indian Air Force flights.
- (c) and (d) The air fare for all the flights operated under Operation Ganga has been borne entirely by the Government and nothing has been charged from the students.
